total viable aerobic count (TAMC)	10'000'000 cfu/g
total combined yeasts/moulds count (TYMC)	100'000 cfu/g
<i>Escherichia coli</i>	1'000 cfu/g
<i>Salmonella</i>	n.d./25 g

The highest recommended limits for TAMC and TYMC amount to the fivefold of the values given above.
